Explanation:

Wildlife crossings in the form of overpasses and fencing were considered by the Idaho Transportation Department as an option in reconstruction of U.S. Highway 20 between its junction with Idaho 87 and the Montana state line ("Targhee Pass") as one potential solution to reduce wildlife-vehicle collisions. As of the date of this ballot the plan for reconstruction of Targhee Pass may be finalized, but it is anticipated that future reconstruction plans of U.S. Highway 20 in Fremont County may include similar proposals. The results of this ballot will provide the Board of County Commissioners for Fremont County, Idaho with an indication of public opinion concerning wildlife crossings. The results of this ballot are not binding on Fremont County or any other governmental entity.
