







The Red Room was once the City Clerk's office.

The Magistrate/District Court room was once part of the Public Library room. The hall next to this room leads to the elevator as well as the Judges Library as well as the Judges room.



The room between the Home Economist office and the Red Room, used to be the Selective Service room. This is where 18 year old males came to sign up for the draft and military paper work was done here.



The room that is part of the Home Extension Agent was once the Selective Agent. This is where the men that turned 18 years of age came to sign up for the draft and other military services were taken care of.



What is now the Motor Vehicle room was at one time the Sheriff's office. Things have certainly changed.



The Health Department Room use to be the old jail. They used to have a "dumb waiter" that went from this room up to the kitchen on the second floor to bring the meals prepared for the prisoners down to the bottom level.



The County Attorney use to be in the Computer Room.



The Assessors room was once the Judges room and the hall next to this room that leads to the elevator used to be part of the Assessor's room.



Later on the Judge moved his room into what is now the EMS/Welfare room.
