Name Clearing Hearing for Bonnie Burlage

Mr. Faler asked that the commissioners rescind the termination or at least give Ms. Burlage the fair opportunity to explain what happened.

Commissioner Hurt stated that Mr. Faler would like another form to respond to the allegations.

Ms. Burlage stated that she would like to understand the allegations and have them explained.

Ms. Burlage asked when she will have an answer from this hearing.

Mr. Hall stated the county has 30 days to make a decision.

Commissioner Hurt closed the hearing.

There being no further business to come before the board the meeting was adjourned.
