2. SITUATION:

A. SIGNIFICANT EVENTS:

A1. 05/04/09, 1625 H1N1 Influenza Received/Stored/Staged (RSS) Operations are complete. IDHW received all CDC SNS material, repackaged, and shipped out to the seven District Health Departments. RSS closed.

B. STATE PRIORITIES:

B1. Monitor the H1N1 Influenza spread and execute the public health anti-viral prepositioning plans.

B2. Provide statewide Situational Awareness regarding the ongoing H1N1 Influenza event.

B3. Support requests for assistance by coordinating with primary emergency support function agencies identified in the Idaho Emergency Operations Plan. At this time Idaho Department of Health and Welfare is the lead agency for this event.

C. DESCRIPTION OF IMMINENT HAZARDS:

H1N1 is a previously unknown virus spread by human to human contact for which there is no existing vaccination, or immunity within humans. This virus has spread from its originating location in Mexico throughout the world. The unique nature of the H1N1 virus creates a potential for this virus to evolve into an influenza strain capable of causing a worldwide pandemic with accompanying loss of life and negative economic impact.

Unknown - Reports will continue while H1N1 Influenza is a potential pandemic or a pandemic.

BHS Regional Area/Location/Incident Description:

North:

PHD conducted conference call with local EM's. Panhandle Health District (PHD) cancelled PanFlu Exercise scheduled for May 14, 09. Local EM's requested an opportunity to provide input to PHD's PanFlu plan following the H1N1 event.

North Central:

North Central Health District continues to provide updated information to emergency managers, Elected Officials, schools and business and coordinates with local partners for receipt of the SNS. All response is organized and functioning according to Incident Command. The number of calls to the Health District has decreased.

Southeast:

Southeast District Health held an Incident Briefing this morning. Ops Section is currently receiving MOU's from all district hospitals for the SNS. Logistics is preparing to receive the SNS and Planning is working on validating volunteers and completing the Incident Action Plans for each day's Operational Period. The EOC Director sent out a mid-day and end-of-day briefing via e-mail to all Initial Response Team staff. The PIO sent out a press release and the Safety Officers are continuing to have all employees fit-tested for N-95 masks.

5. STATUS OF STATE OPERATIONS:

ID-ESF #5 Information and Planning: BHS supporting information flow through monitoring and reporting (Monitoring WebEOC). IDEOC Plans is coordinating with DHW to address the response requirements if this advances into an interstate or regional epidemiological emergency.

ID-ESF #8 Health and Medical: IDHW and the Health Districts are coordinating with hospitals and other state and federal agencies, and providing information regarding the spread of the virus and ways to protect from it. Health Districts are preparing to receive SNS stock 5/5/09; no delays have been reported.
