1. The initial weigh-in for hogs designated to show at the Fremont County Fair will be Saturday, May 1, 2010 at 9:00 am at the Fremont County Fairgrounds.
2. The standard feeding period for Fremont County will be 96 days in length.
3. In order for an exhibitor to be able to show and/sell an animal at the Fremont County Fair, he/she must be the owner and primary caretaker of the animal for 96 days before the show. ANY CHANGE IN OWNERSHIP MUST BE MADE WITHIN 24 HOURS OF INITIAL WEIGH-IN AND APPROVED BY THE LIVESTOCK COMMITTEE AND THE EXTENSION OFFICE.
4. All hogs must be on ground and checked in by 5:00 pm, Thursday, August 5, 2010. All hogs must be weighted between 5:00 – 6:00pm. Hogs will be weighed during this time only.

RULES FOR FITTING & SHOWING

ALL classes of market stock, feeders and breeding animals are eligible to compete in the fitting and showing contest.

ALL animals in the fitting and showing contest must be shown in a quality, feeder or breeding class.

ALL Fit & Showing must be shown by exhibitor and all animals must be owned by the exhibitor.

The fitting and showing contest shall be judged on the following:

1. Fitting of the animal – cleanliness
2. Training of the animal
3. Showmanship ability of exhibitor
4. Appearance of exhibitor
