1. Any boy or girl in 4-H or FFA, 8 to 18 (age as of Jan. 1, 2010) may exhibit a horse project, if they have handed in a horse identification sheet and payment was made to the Fremont County Extension Office by April 17, 2010 by 5:00 pm.
2. 4-H/FFA clothing standard will be long sleeved button or snap-up shirt or blouse tucked in with jeans that are in good repair and clean, hat, boots, and belt.
3. All classes will be judged according to Eastern Idaho State Fair rules.
4. Youth should be proper level for Working Ranch Horse. A committee will determine if youth can participate.
5. The EISF Junior Horse Show Committee encourages each county show to instruct judges to only recommend exhibitors with sufficient skill to be awarded the opportunity to show at the EISF Junior Horse Show. This will be enforced at the show.
