Fremont County Development Code – 2011 Edition

1. **Minimum Length:** Driveways (other than those serving single family dwellings) shall be of sufficient design to allow vehicles to exit the property without backing into the road (Appendix C - 1.09.010).
2. **Maximum Length:** Where a single access (i.e. cul-de-sac or dead-end road) is provided for more than one non-farm structure, the length shall not exceed 440' (Appendix B – 1.10.030)
3. **Minimum Width and Slope:** Driveways and roads for a single-family dwelling shall have a minimum width of 10 feet with a curb radius of 5 feet where it intersects the county road. The road or driveway approach to the county road shall not exceed a 12% grade. (Appendix C - 1.09.060)
4. **Arterial Road Access Points:** Driveways and roads shall be sited and designed to minimize the number of access points to **arterial** roads (Appendix C - 1.09.020).
5. **Drainage:** Within the county road easement or right-of-way along the applicant's property line, the following shall be constructed.
 - a. **Drainage Ditch:** Shall be a minimum depth of 24 inches measured from the edge of the roadway shoulder and seeded for grass as recommended by the local NRCS Service (Appendix B - 1.13.020).
 - b. **Culvert:** Shall have a minimum diameter of 12 inches, a minimum length of 30 feet, consist of corrugated steel, aluminum or concrete, and be covered by at least 12 inches of material (Appendix B - 1.13.040 & Appendix C - 1.09.070).
6. **Site Triangle:** No sight-obstruction between 3' and 12' shall violate the clear vision triangle (Appendix B – 1.10.050-080 & Appendix C - 1.09.050). Sight obstructions can include vegetation, fences, parked cars, tree branches, walls and any other object blocking sight of oncoming traffic.
7. **Intersection Distance** (Appendix B – 1.10.020 & Appendix C – 1.09.030-040):
 - a. **Adjacent access point:** Access point must be at least 10 feet (for driveways) and 50 feet (for roads) from an adjacent access point, *as measured from the nearest side of each road or driveway.*
 - b. **Accessing local road:** Access point must be at least 20 feet (for driveways) and 125 feet (for roads) from an intersection with another local road or alley, *as measured from the corner lot line of the intersection to the nearest side of the road or driveway.*
 - c. **Accessing collector road:** Access point must be at least 60 feet (for driveways) and 125 feet (for roads) from its intersection with any local road and at least 200 feet from its intersection with another collector road, *as measured from the corner lot line of the intersection to the nearest side of the road or driveway.* The current edition of the ITD Functional Classification System Map will be used to determine road type.
 - d. **Accessing state highway:** Permits allowing access to state highways shall be acquired from the Idaho Transportation Department and shall be subject to their rules.
