An Ordinance establishing a 60 day time period following the submission of a beer license application within which the County Commissioners must make a decision to deny or allow issuance of the license, and establishing that an application shall be deemed allowed if it is not allowed or denied within the 60 day period.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Fremont County, Idaho, that an ordinance creating a time limit for commission action on beer license applications be established as follows:

Within 60 days after the filing of a beer license application, the Board of County Commissioners shall act thereon and notify the applicant in writing of its allowance or denial. An application shall be deemed to have been allowed if at the end of the 60 day period the Board of County Commissioners has failed to allow or deny the application.
