

ORDINANCE #83-2


AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPEED LIMIT OF 10 M.P.H. FOR AQUATIC TRAVEL ON THE HENRY'S FORK OUTLET, ALSO KNOWN AS GOOSE BAY, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREMONT COUNTY, IDAHO, THAT A 10 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT BE ESTABLISHED FOR AQUATIC TRAVEL ON THE HENRY'S FORK OUTLET, ALSO KNOWN AS GOOSE BAY, AND PENALTIES PROVIDED FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AS FOLLOWS:


(a) It is unlawful for any person to drive or pilot any aquatic or other vehicle on the Henry's Fork Outlet, also known as Goose Bay, at a speed in excess of 10 m.p.h.

(b) Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor criminal offense, and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$300.00, or by imprisonment not to exceed 6 months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
