

ORDINANCE NO. 86-14

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE GENERAL PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ANY FREMONT COUNTY ORDINANCE UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREMONT COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A. Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of any ordinance of the County of Fremont, State of Idaho, is guilty of a misdemeanor. Except in cases where a different punishment is prescribed by any ordinance of the City of Fremont, any person convicted of a misdemeanor under the ordinances of Fremont County, Idaho, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$300 dollars or by imprisonment not to exceed six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

B. Each such person is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation any provision of the ordinances of Fremont County is committed, continued or permitted by any such person, and he is punishable accordingly.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.
