

ORDINANCE NO. 90-2

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT ILLEGAL TO LOITER UPON THE PREMISES OF THE FREMONT COUNTY COURTHOUSE OR SURROUNDING GROUNDS OR ON ANY FREMONT COUNTY PROPERTY; DEFINING THE TERMS USED HEREIN; DESCRIBING THE PENALTIES HEREOF; AND, PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FREMONT COUNTY IDAHO AS FOLLOWS.


1. It is illegal for any person to loiter on the premises of the Fremont County Courthouse or surrounding grounds or on any other real or personal property owned by Fremont County.

2. Loitering is defined as the presence on county property of any person who is present there without any business purpose and whose presence in any way detracts from or hinders the operation of the property or the employment of any person present thereon.


3. Any person found in violation of this ordinance shall be fined an amount not to exceed \$100.00 and or shall be subject to imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed 10 days.

4. This ordinance shall be in full force in effect from and after it's passage and publication all as provided by law.
