

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THAT PORTION OF FREMONT COUNTY ORDINANCE 98-1 COMPRISING FREMONT COUNTY CODE SECTION 13.01.180 BY DELETING THAT PORTION OF SUBSECTION A, THE AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AS A CONNECTION FEE, AND PROVIDING THAT CONNECTION FEES SHALL BE DETERMINED AS SET OUT IN SECTION 13.01.181; ADDING A NEW SECTION 13.01.181 TO PROVIDE FOR SEWER CAPITALIZATION FEES TO BE DETERMINED AND UTILIZED AS CONNECTION FEES, SUCH FEES TO BE SET BY ANNUAL RESOLUTION OR ORDINANCE; AND, ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREMONT COUNTY, IDAHO, THAT FREMONT COUNTY CODE SECTION 13.01.180 BE AMENDED AND A NEW SECTION 13.01.181 BE ADDED, AS SET OUT BELOW:

13.01.180 Sewer connection fee. The sewer connection fees after June 1, 1998 shall be as follows:

A. Each connection inside County limits/ shall pay a connection fee as determined in Section 13.01.181, below.

Size of Sewer Connection	Connection Fee
4"	\$3,000.00
8" (shall include manhole)	\$15,000.00

B. Fee for each sewer connection outside of the Fremont County boundaries connecting to the collecting system and/or pressure line shall be the applicable above connection fees for inside County limits and in addition thereto sixty percent (60%) of such fee.

C. All fees shall be paid to the County Inspector at the time of issuance of the patron's building permit.

All sewer connections made inside and/or outside the County limits to the interceptor line shall be made according to the plans and specifications approved by the County Engineer of the County, which may also limit the number of service connections on a lateral line connecting to the original system in or outside the County limits and/or the pressure line.

Any special connections not covered by the above schedules shall have fees set by the County Commissioners in each individual situation.

The foregoing fees are for the privilege of connecting with the County sewer and all work necessary for making proper connection shall be done to the satisfaction of and under the supervision of the County Inspector and shall be paid for by the

person desiring such connection, and such persons shall pay a permit fee of ____-0-____ dollars (\$ ____-0-____) and an inspection fee of ____-0-____ dollars (\$ ____-0-____), except for all services installed prior to the effective date of this Chapter.

13.01.181 Sewer Capitalization Fee:

In order for the City to meet its obligation under the Idaho Revenue Bond Act 50-1027, et. seq., and other laws to operate its sewer system and collect reasonable and equitable rates, fees, tolls and charges and to recover the costs at operating, maintaining, replacing and depreciating the existing sewer system and extensions thereof, with the objective of said system being self supporting, from time to time the County Commission by resolution or subsequent ordinance may establish a reasonable sewer capitalization fee which shall be reviewed on an annual basis. The method of calculating said fee shall be specified in said resolution or subsequent ordinance. At no time shall the County establish such a fee solely as a source of general revenue for the County.

This amendment to the ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage and publication, as provided by law.
