

FREMONT COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2000-03

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT POSSESSION OF A FIREARM, OTHER DANGEROUS WEAPON, EXPLOSIVE OR INCENDIARY DEVICE WITHIN A FREMONT COUNTY PUBLIC BUILDING CONSTITUTES COMMISSION OF A MISDEMEANOR, PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREMONT COUNTY:

Pursuant to authority under Article XII, Section 2 of the Constitution of the State of Idaho and the requirements of Chapter 7 of Title 31, Idaho Code, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

Section 1.0 Short Title.

Section 1.1 This ordinance shall be known and cited as the Fremont County Firearms and Dangerous Weapons Ordinance.

Section 2.0 Purpose.

Section 2.1 The purpose of this ordinance is to prohibit the possession of a firearm, other dangerous weapon, explosive or incendiary device in any public building, owned or operated by Fremont County "wherein any elected official, court of the State of Idaho or any judicial officer is housed or has offices," and making such possession a misdemeanor violation, except in those circumstances where the individual carrying or possessing the firearm, other dangerous weapon, explosive or incendiary device is law enforcement personnel.

Section 3.0 Definitions.

Section 3.1 Except as provided herein, all words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall be given their ordinary, commonly understood and accepted meaning.

Section 4.0 Exceptions.

Section 4.1 This ordinance does not apply to law enforcement personnel of the State of Idaho, or to law enforcement personnel of any of the counties or cities within the State of Idaho, including criminal investigators of the Attorney General's office, the Attorney General and Deputy Attorney Generals, criminal investigators of a prosecuting attorney's office, prosecuting attorneys and deputy prosecuting attorneys or to law enforcement personnel of the United States of America or to any duly elected or appointed judges of the State of Idaho or of the United States of America.

Section 5.0 Weapon possession.

Section 5.1 It shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession a firearm, other dangerous weapon, explosive or incendiary device whether loaded or unloaded, while said person is within any public building, owned and operated by Fremont County "wherein any elected official, court of the State of Idaho or any judicial officer is housed or has offices." Any person convicted of a violation of this prohibition shall be punished by a fine of not more that \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6.0 Publication and Effective Date.

Section 6.1 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the County Commissioners of the County of Fremont and its due publication as required by law.
