

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-06

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF CAMPGROUND FACILITIES AT FROME PARK; MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON OR PARTY TO CAMP AT FROME PARK LONGER THAN FIFTEEN CONSECUTIVE DAYS IN ANY SIX WEEK PERIOD; DECLARING THE PUNISHMENT THEREFOR; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND, ESTABLISHING THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREMONT COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Campground facilities at the William K. Frome Park at Henry's Lake in Fremont County, Idaho may be used by any person or party, on a first come first served basis, without fee.

2. It is unlawful for any campground facility at said Frome Park to be used by any person or party for more than fifteen consecutive days in any six week period.

3. It is unlawful for any person or party to leave any vehicle or recreational equipment unattended for more than 24 hours. In addition to any other penalty assessed herein, any vehicles or equipment unattended for more than 24 hours may be towed.

4. Any person violating this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor criminal offense, punishable by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail of not more than ten days, or by both such fine or imprisonment. Each day of violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

5. Any ordinance or portion thereof in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, on April 1, 2001.
