

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN IDENTIFIED PERMANENT AND SEMI-PERMANENT RECORDS MAINTAINED BY THE FREMONT COUNTY PLANNING AND BUILDING DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Fremont County Planning and Building Department has determined that certain identified permanent and semi-permanent records maintained by such Department have been retained for not less than the statutory retention time of ten (10) years and five (5) years, respectively:

WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Fremont Planning and Building Department has sought the advice of the prosecuting attorney on the request to destroy permanent and semi-permanent records;

WHEREAS, the prosecuting attorney advises that the permanent and semi-permanent records have been retained for a period of time not less than the statutory time requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has conducted a regular audit of the records.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that:

Section 1. The records of Fremont County identified on Schedule "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference be destroyed.

Section 2. Disposition of the above-identified records shall be performed under the direction and supervision of the board's clerk.

This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by a majority of the Board of County Commissioners.



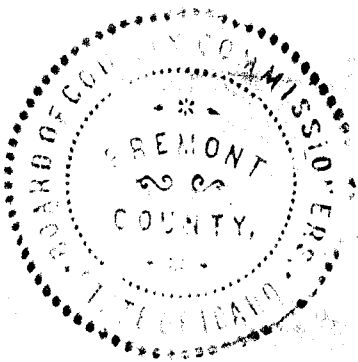
