RESOLUTION NO. 2018- 18

THE FREMONT COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS DESIRES TO DECLARE,
BY RESOLUTION, A PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY AN ODD-LOT PROPERTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FREMONT
COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

That Fremont County's Macks Inn Holding Jail, a 384 square foot concrete block building on a 384 square foot tract of land, Unit 34 of the Macks Inn Village Planned Unit Development Plat, as part of the recorded plat thereof, Island Park, Fremont County, is no longer needed for public purposes and excess to the needs to the County. It is a remnant of a once larger piece of land and given the land's small size has value primarily to an adjoining land owner.

That the Mack's Inn Holding Jail, and the land it sits on, as described above, is hereby declared an odd-lot property pursuant to Idaho Code section 31-808(8).


This resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
