








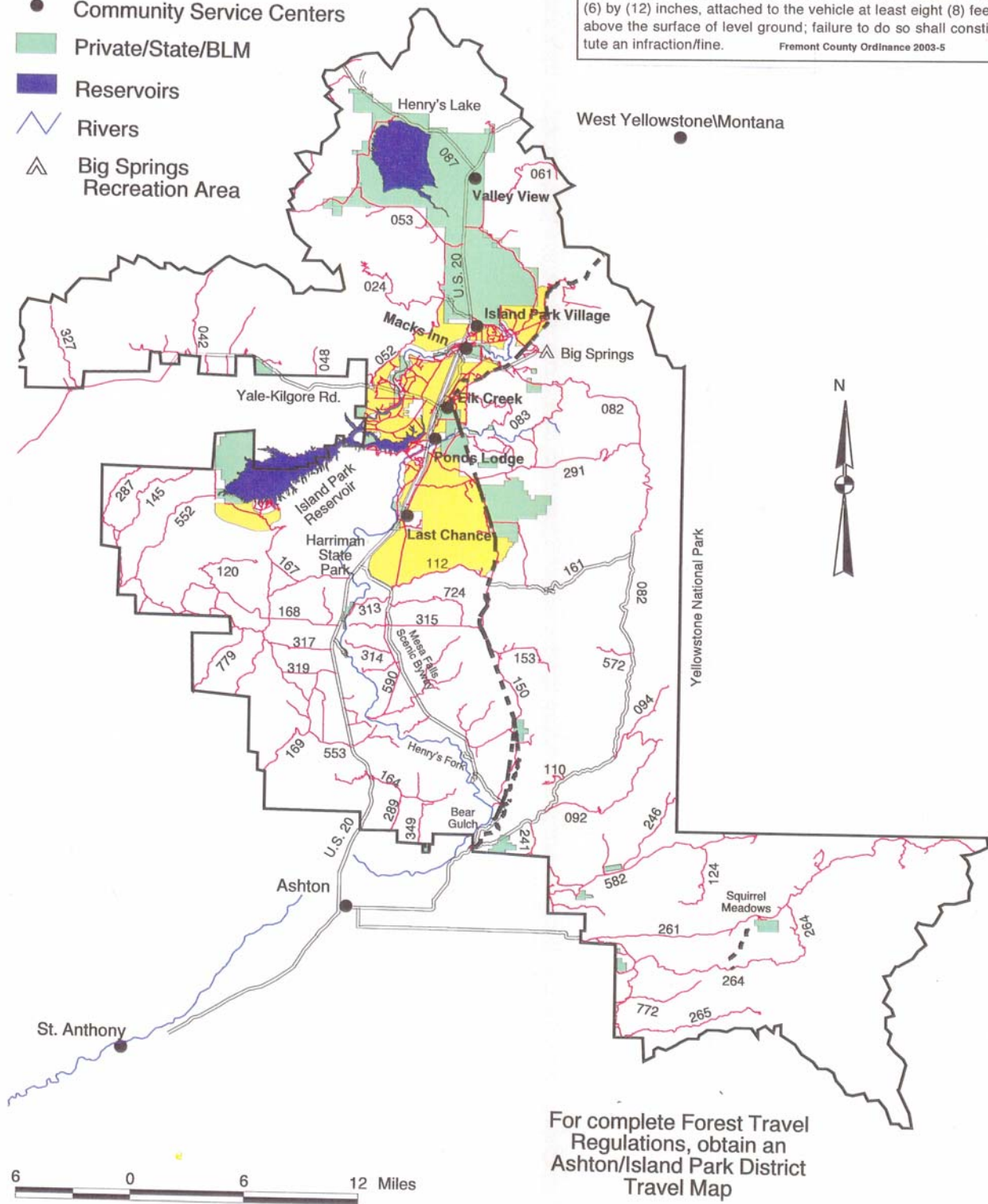


ATV User Guide

Attention All ATV/Off Highway Vehicle Operators
 Operators of all off highway vehicles within Fremont County (excluding snowmobiles) must operate their off highway vehicles with a red or orange safety flag, that is a minimum of six (6) by (12) inches, attached to the vehicle at least eight (8) feet above the surface of level ground; failure to do so shall constitute an infraction/fine. Fremont County Ordinance 2003-5
